The student should be in the top half of the class but not in the top 20 %. The North Allegheny Foundation is pleased to administer and will continue to fund this scholarship opportunity.

The North Allegheny Foundation is offering a \$2,000 scholarship to a student who demonstrates the following characteristics:

- 1. An ability to overcome challenges when pursuing personal goals*
- 2. A Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.8 or higher.*
- 3. Improved academic performance or maintenance of adequate achievement in spite of personal hardships or challenges*
- 4. An interest in pursuing a four-year college or university education.*
